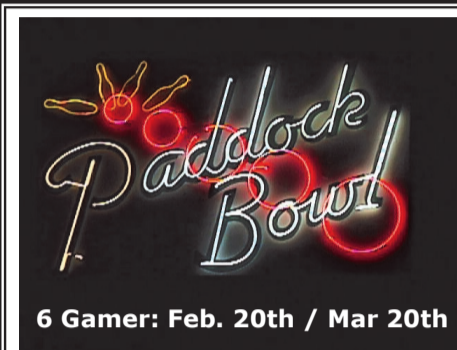

On Nov. 12, 2009 Rod Hussey 79, a 35 year resident of Bay Point, CA became the newest member of the 300 club at Diablo Lanes. Rod a bowler for over 25 years never thought that he would see the day. Rod started bowling many years ago at Concord Bowl, then moved to Pleasant Hill Lanes and eventually to Diablo Lanes when Pleasant Hill Lanes closed in 1998. Rod and his wife Karen have been avid bowlers in the Diablo Valley Mixed 5's League on Thursday nights as well as long time members of our Match Club. Rod back in 1999 came back from a career and life threatening illness with severe ulcers which later caused staff infections which made it very difficult for him to walk. Karen Hussey, Rod's wife, encouraged Rod to get back into bowling after nearly a years absence due to the illness. With the patience of Karen, Rod started back in 1999 with the aid of a wheel chair and an 8 lb bowling ball. Rod's average which use to be 185 to 195 was all the way down to 85 when he started back bowling. Rod created a 1 step delivery to release the ball and raised his average to a current 174 average of today. On Nov. 12, 2009 Rod Hussey who still after 10 years of a 1 step approach entered the 300 club for the very 1st time. At the age of 79 is remarkable enough but to use only a 1 step delivery is remarkable.

Rod called his wife Karen who is currently living in Yelm Washington waiting for their current house to sell, received a phone call from Rod and she couldn't believe it! Karen said a 300 game? Is that for 2 games? Rod said no and we gave him a print out to prove it to her. Rod's previous career high game was 290 and he has a career high series of 723.

Rod says that he owes everything to his wife Karen who has taught him everything that he knows about the great sport of bowling.

All the members of the Diablo Valley Mixed 5's league were just amazed by watching this great feat and we are all very proud to have witnessed this fine accomplishment. Keep up the great bowling Rod and Congratulations!
